MEMBER RULES

- No outside food or drinks are allowed to be brought onto any property (golf course, pool, driving range, clubhouse, etc).
- Adhere to the dress code at all times:
 - Golf course and club house:
 - *Men:* (including Juniors) are required to wear pants or Bermuda length shorts. Shirts with collars are required and should be tucked in. No running shirts, tank tops, t-shirts, mesh shirts, sweatpants, swimsuits, or running/coaching shorts will be permitted. Mock turtlenecks and sweaters without collars will be allowed. Denim fabrics are allowed, provided they are neat and in good taste.
 - *Ladies:* (including Juniors) are required to wear golf dresses, skirts, blouses, slacks, or Bermuda length shorts. Halter tops, running shorts, short shorts, swimsuits, tank tops, and tops exposing the midriff are not allowed. Denim fabrics are allowed, provided they are neat and in good taste.
 - Only soft spike golf shoes are allowed.
 - Driving range, practice green, and fitness:
 - *Men:* (including Juniors) can wear the attire listed above for the course or appropriate athletic attire, as long as in good condition and in good taste. No tank tops or muscle shirts, mesh shirts, or swimsuits will be permitted.
 - *Ladies:* (including Juniors) can wear the attire listed above for the course or appropriate athletic attire, as long as in good condition and in good taste. No mesh shirts, swimsuits, sports bras, or tops exposing the midriff will be permitted.
 - Only soft spike golf shoes are allowed.
- Proper pace of play should not exceed four hours and 30 minutes during regular conditions. Cart path only conditions will allow for more time. The appropriate position on the course is directly behind the group in front of you, and respectful of their game. Staff reserves the right to monitor play and require players that cannot keep pace to allow other groups through or advancing to their proper place on the course. Groups unable or unwilling to maintain a proper pace may be asked to leave the course. At the turn, do not plan to stop and eat lunch. To go orders can be called in, there is a sign before the 9th tee with the phone number to call.
- A driver's license is required to operate golf carts. Appropriate care should be taken at all times when driving and parking golf carts to avoid injury and damage. Please see the safety stickers on the carts. Children should not be left on or around a golf cart alone.
- All posted signs apply to members as well as any other golfers.
 - Follow golf course etiquette at all times, including remaining on the cart path around all tees, greens, and the entire par 3 holes; filling all divots with sand, especially on the tees and in the fairways; repairing all ball marks on greens; raking bunkers; etc.
- Any violation of these rules, or any other posted or communicated rules, may result in suspension or revocation of membership privileges at the discretion of management.

MEMBERSHIP FAQs

GOLF MEMBERSHIPS

Q: Can I use my own cart to play golf?

A: You can, with these stipulations: sign up to pay for the \$60/month private cart trail fee on your application, use a Club Car that is either beige, green, or white, schedule all tee times, and check in at the Pro Shop prior to any play.

Q: Can I pay monthly to rent a golf cart?

A: You can, with these stipulations: sign up to pay for the \$175/month retail cart trail fee on your application, and 1 member is covered for rental cart fees for the month.

Q: Can I walk the round, carrying a bag or using a push cart?

A: Walking is permitted, as long as you do not impede pace of play. You must still schedule tee times and check in at the Pro Shop prior to any play.

Q: Are my spouse and children considered members as well?

A: Your spouse that resides at your address has membership benefits as long as you do. Spouse does not include one who is not married to you, is separated from you or from whom you are divorced. Your children have membership benefits if they reside with you and if they are 22 years of age or younger. The term child (or children) includes your biological child, adopted child or step-child so long as he/she/they reside with you at your address listed in your application.

Q: If the weather is bad, can I get a golf rain check?

A: Yes, if you have already paid for your round, and the course is closed due to weather, please see the Pro Shop for the applicable rain check.

Q: Can my kids swim while I play golf?

A: Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times at the pool.

Q: Can I get golf lessons at Windance and are they included in my membership?

A: Yes, we can do golf lessons, but no they are not included in a membership. Contact Micky D'Angelo regarding instructors, pricing, and scheduling.

Q: Are range balls included with the golf membership?

A: Yes, this is included in your monthly membership fee. The fee allows you 70 – 80 range balls per 24-hour period, whenever the driving range is open.

Q: How does the Hole-in-One Club work?

A: Sign up on your application and \$10 is added to your first invoice. If anyone in the Club hits a hole-in-one, they receive Pro Shop credit for their winning amount. All members in the Club are then charged \$10 again on the next invoice. This cycle will continue to repeat unless you choose to cancel the Hole-in-One Club.

Q: Is there a group that plays regularly that I can join?

A: Yes! We have two groups that you can join:

1. The lunch bunch plays on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday at noon. You are welcome to play any or all of those days. To sign up, call the Pro Shop by 11:30am, check in when you get here, and be at the practice green by 11:50am.
2. The Windance Golf Association (WGA) plays on Thursday evenings at 5:30pm. To sign up, call the Pro Shop by 5:00pm, check in when you get here, and be at the practice green by 5:20pm. There is a one-time entry fee for the season, more details are available from the Assistant Golf Professional.

Q: How do I pay for my membership?

A: Once you complete the application and turn it in with a copy of your Driver's License to the Pro Shop, then representatives from the accounting department at the casino, will contact you for invoicing and payment information. They will also print your discount cards and mail those to you. You are welcome to contact them at any time during your membership regarding the billing, by dialing (228) 314-2184.

Q: How long do I have to be a Golf or a Social Member before I can cancel?

A: At least one (1) year. If you cancel prior to that, there is a 6 month waiting period before you can join again.

Q: Can we bring friends to swim at the pool?

A: Yes, but the member must be present with the guest. The guest fee is \$10 for each guest, whether adult or child. Children must be under your supervision if they are not accompanied by another adult.

Q: If the weather is bad, can I get a pool rain check?

A: We do not offer rain checks from the pool. You are required to leave the pool area during inclement weather when the alarm sounds for your safety. You are welcome to return to the pool once the weather has passed out of the area if it is re-opened.

Swimming Pool Rules & Policies

(Last Updated: January 16, 2026)

1. General House Rules

- These **Windance Swimming Pool Rules & Policies** are a supplement to the Windance Country Club General House Rules.
- Windance Country Club will not provide lifeguards and will do everything possible to promote safety of swimmers, but assumes no responsibility for any injury or accidents in connection with the swimming pool operation. All will swim at their own risk.

2. Access and Eligibility to Swimming Pool

- The Windance Swimming Pool is exclusively available to current Country Club members, or guests otherwise granted written permission to use the facility.
- Members (or authorized guests) must have with them their ID to enter the Swimming Pool and will present same upon request to verify membership.
- Pool hours are from 7am to 7pm, when the clubhouse is open, and may be changed without notice at the discretion of Windance Country Club Management. Lap time is 7am-9am, Tuesday – Friday.
- All pool members and their guests must check in with a Pool Attendant or Bar Staff each day.
- The guest fee is \$10 per person. The member must be present for the guest to enter or to stay at the pool.
- Minor age grandchildren are permitted on memberships. Children no longer living in the household or older than 22 are considered guests.

3. Age Restrictions

- Members (or authorized guests) under the age of 14 are not permitted to use the Swimming Pool unless accompanied and directly supervised by a parent or legal guardian who is also a member (or authorized guest) with Swimming Pool privileges.
- Parents or legal guardians are solely responsible for the conduct and safety of their minor children at all times while at the facility.

4. Supervision Requirements

- "Direct supervision" means the parent or guardian must be present in the same pool area, monitoring the minor's activity, and not engaged in separate activities that prevent proper supervision.

5. General Conduct and Safety

- NO OUTSIDE COOLERS, FOOD, OR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED.
- Proper pool attire must be worn at all times, and proper clubhouse attire must be worn at all times when entering the facility.
- Persons in bathing suits are not allowed outside of the swimming pool area. If there is no Pool Attendant on duty, then food and drink orders must be placed via the bar window inside the back patio door.
- No horseplay, running, pushing, shoving, scuffling, or disruptive behavior will be tolerated.
- Members (or authorized guests) are expected to follow all posted safety guidelines and to follow any and all instructions from club staff.

- No glass is allowed in the pool area at any time.
- Windance Country Club will not be responsible for recovering or storing any items left at the pool.
- The pool will close any time inclement weather prevents safe swimming conditions. Windance Country Club Management may, or may not, choose to re-open the pool after the inclement weather has passed.

6. Other

- Cabanas may be rented for half days for \$10 on weekdays, \$20 on weekends, and \$30 on holidays. Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis. All cabana rentals can be done through the Pool Attendant/Bar Staff.
- If there is no Pool Attendant on duty, only 1 gate will be unlocked for entry/exit closest to the building. You will be required to check in with the Bar Staff on those days. If you need the parking lot gate to be unlocked for easier access, feel free to call the bar and let them know to meet you out there for both entry and exit and to check you in. 228-832-4871, press 2.

7. Violations

- Any violation of these rules may result in suspension or revocation of Swimming Pool privileges at the discretion of management.

Fitness Center Rules & Policies

(Last Updated: November 11, 2025)

1. General House Rules

- These **Windance Fitness Center Rules & Policies** are a supplement to the Windance Country Club General House Rules.

2. Access and Eligibility to Fitness Center

- The Windance Fitness Center is exclusively available to current Country Club members, or guests otherwise granted written permission to use the facility.
- Members (or authorized guests) must have with them their ID to enter the Fitness Center and will present same upon request to verify membership.

3. Age Restrictions

- Members (or authorized guests) under the age of 17 are not permitted to use the Fitness Center unless accompanied and directly supervised by a parent or legal guardian who is also a member (or authorized guest) with Fitness Center privileges.
- Parents or legal guardians are solely responsible for the conduct and safety of their minor children at all times while in the facility.

4. Supervision Requirements

- "Direct supervision" means the parent or guardian must be present in the same workout area, monitoring the minor's activity, and not engaged in separate activities that prevent proper supervision.
- **Children under the age of 14 are not permitted in the Fitness Center under any circumstances, including as spectators.**

5. General Conduct and Safety

- Proper athletic attire must be worn at all times.
- Equipment must be wiped down after use.
- No horseplay, loitering, or disruptive behavior will be tolerated.
- Members (or authorized guests) are expected to follow all posted safety guidelines and to follow any and all instructions from club staff.

6. Violations

- Any violation of these rules may result in suspension or revocation of Fitness Center privileges at the discretion of management.
